THE ART OF DULCIMER/Robert Force & Albert d'Ossché

Over the past ten years Robert Force and Albert d'Ossché have pioneered new techniques and music on the mountain dulcimer - an instrument that has long since left the Appalachians and can now be truly considered as the American dulcimer, played by people everywhere.

This album of instrumental music has been arranged for fine listening as well as use by students of the dulcimer. Everyone who plays dulcimer (or enjoys the variety of music that can be played on it) will find on this album something to delight and interest them. The ten selections fully illustrate the sound and techniques of Force & d'Ossché's innovative "stand-up, overhand" playing style. Some pieces are basic, some are designed for the intermediate player, while others are quite challenging in their use of cross-rhythms, counterpoint, syncopation, and phrasing.

An accompanying music book for this album and their previous one ("Crossover" KM-308) is available (see below). The Art of Dulcimer in the Style of Robert Force & Albert d'Ossché contains music written in dulcimer tablature along with conventional notation, guitar chords, and complete lyrics. Although not a "method book" it will prove to be valuable for beginning and intermediate students as well as the experienced player.

So here is the American Dulcimer interpreted by two of the nation's foremost innovators and stylists. While blending the instrument's Appalachian roots with contemporary arrangements, Force & d'Ossché display the timing and technique that has made them dulcimer virtuosos.
